**An Act to amend the Companies (Administration) Act, 1982.**

*[Assented to 10 May 1984]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Companies (Administration) Act Amendment Act, 1984". Short title.

(2) The Companies (Administration) Act, 1982, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 6 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (3) and substituting the following subsection: Amendment of s. 6—  
Corporate Affairs Commission.

(3) The Commission shall be constituted of—

(a) the Commissioner for Corporate Affairs;

(b) the Deputy Commissioner for Corporate Affairs;

or

(c) the Assistant Commissioner for Corporate Affairs.

3. The following section is inserted after section 8 of the principal Act. Insertion of new section 8a.  
Report.

8a. (1) The Commission shall, on or before the thirty-first day of December in each year, deliver to the Minister a report of its operations during the period of twelve months that ended on the preceding thirtieth day of June.

(2) The Minister shall cause a copy of the report to be laid before each House of Parliament.
