## No. 64 of 1978

An Act to amend the Constitution Act, 1934-1978.

*[Assented to 28th September, 1978]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Constitution Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1978".

(2) The Constitution Act, 1934-1978, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Constitution Act, 1934-1978".

2. Section 65 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (1) the word "twelve" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "thirteen".
