An Act to amend the Constitution Act, 1934, as amended.

[Assented to 19th November, 1970]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Constitution Act Amendment Act (No. 3), 1970".
- (2) The Constitution Act, 1934-1969, as amended by this Act and by all Acts amending the same prior to the enactment of this Act, may be cited as the "Constitution Act, 1934-1970".
- (3) The Constitution Act, 1934-1969, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 65— Number of Ministers of the Crown.

- 2. Section 65 of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by striking out from subsection (1) the word "nine" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "ten";
 - (b) by striking out from subsection (2) the word "six" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "seven".
