## No. 45 of 1952.

An Act to amend the Companies Act, 1934-1939.

[Assented to 4th December, 1952.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Companies Act Amendment Act, 1952".
- (2) The Companies Act, 1934-1939, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Companies Act, 1934-1952".
- (3) The Companies Act, 1934-1939, is hereinafter called "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 129—
Annual return,

3. Section 129 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the words "thirty days" in the second line of subsection (1) thereof and inserting in their place the words "one month".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 130— Annual return

- Annual return to be made by a company not having share capital.
- 4. Section 130 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the words "thirty days" in the second line of subsection (1) thereof and inserting in their place the words "one month".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 176—
Returns to be

s. 176— Returns to be made by noliability companies. 5. Section 176 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the words "thirty days" in the first line of subsection (1) thereof and inserting in their place the words "one month".

6. Section 353 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word "five" in the last line of subsection (2) and inserting in its place the word "three".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 363—Company to have registered office.
