An Act to amend the Constitution Act, 1934, as amended.

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Constitution Act Amendment Act, 1975".

(2) The Constitution Act, 1934-1974, as amended by the Constitution Act Amendment Act, 1975, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Constitution Act, 1934-1975".

2. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of July, 1974.

3. Section 73a of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out from paragraph (a) of subsection (1) the passage "nineteen thousand seven hundred" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "twenty-two thousand six hundred";

(b) by striking out from paragraph (b) of subsection (1) the passage "nineteen thousand seven hundred" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "twenty-two thousand six hundred".
