An Act to amend the Citrus Industry Organization Act, 1965-1971.

[Assented to 7th December, 1972]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Citrus Industry Organization Act Amendment Act, 1972". Short titles.

(2) The Citrus Industry Organization Act, 1965-1971, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Citrus Industry Organization Act, 1965-1972".

(3) The Citrus Industry Organization Act, 1965-1971, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation. Commencement.

3. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by inserting immediately before the word "means" in the definition of "representative member" the passage " , until the prescribed day, "; Amendment of principal Act, s. 5— Interpretation.

(b) by inserting immediately after the passage "of this Act" in the definition of "representative member" the passage

“and on and after the prescribed day means a member who has been appointed under paragraph (b) of subsection (1a) of section 9 of this Act”;

and

(c) by inserting after the definition of “the Committee” the following definition:—

“the prescribed day” means the day declared by proclamation to be the prescribed day for the purposes of section 9 of this Act..

4. Section 9 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by inserting immediately after subsection (1) the following subsection:—

(1a) On the prescribed day the members of the Committee then in office shall vacate their respective offices and on and from the prescribed day the Committee shall consist of seven members appointed by the Governor of whom—

(a) one shall be a person appointed by the Governor to be the Chairman of the Committee;

(b) four shall be persons who have been duly elected by registered growers in accordance with this Act;

and

(c) two shall be persons who, in the opinion of the Governor, have extensive knowledge of and experience in marketing.

5. Section 17 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (5) the word “Three” and inserting in lieu thereof the word “Four”.
