An Act to amend "The Crown Lands Amendment Act, 1882."

[Assented to, February 28th, 1884.]

HEREAS it is desirable to extend the time provided by Preamble. "The Crown Lands Amendment Act, 1882," for the surrender by selectors of existing agreements—Be it therefore Enacted by the Governor of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said province, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:

The second section of "The Crown Lands Amendment Act, Substitution of March 1882," shall be read as if the words "thirty-first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-four," had been inserted in the sec. 2 of Act No. 275 of 1882. said section in lieu of the words "first day of December, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-three."

In the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
