An Act to amend the Crown Lands Act, 1929-1966.

[Assented to 30th March, 1967.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the “Crown Lands Act Amendment Act, 1967”. Short title.

(2) The Crown Lands Act, 1929-1966, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the “Crown Lands Act, 1929-1967”.

(3) The Crown Lands Act, 1929-1966, is hereinafter referred to as “the principal Act”.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. Section 31 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out the words “fifteen thousand dollars” in paragraphs (a) and (b) of subsection (1) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof in each case the words “twenty-five thousand dollars” ;

and

(b) by striking out the words “one thousand dollars” in subsection (2) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the words “two thousand dollars”.
