An Act to amend the City of Adelaide Development Control Act, 1976.

[Assented to 11 December 1986]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the “City of Adelaide Development Control Act Amendment Act, 1986”. Short title.

(2) The City of Adelaide Development Control Act, 1976, is in this Act referred to as “the principal Act”.

2. Section 30 of the principal Act is amended by striking out “referred to in section 28 of” and substituting “under”. Amendment of s. 30—  
Commencement of appeal.

3. Section 32 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out from subsection (1) “the appeal and shall have regard to section 24, 24a, 25 or 25a as the case requires” and substituting “an appeal referred to in section 28”;

(b) by inserting after subsection (1) the following subsection:

(1a) The Tribunal shall, when determining an appeal under this Act, have regard to matters to which the Council or Commission was required to have regard in the first instance.;

and

(c) by inserting in subsection (2) “under this Act” after “At the hearing of an appeal”.

Amendment of s. 32—
