## No. 67 of 1982

An Act to amend the Companies (Application of Laws) Act, 1982.

[Assented to 1 July 1982]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Companies (Application of Laws) short titles. Act Amendment Act, 1982".
- (2) The Companies (Application of Laws) Act, 1982, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".
- (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Companies (Application of Laws) Act, 1982".
- 2. Schedule 1 to the principal Act is amended by inserting after clause 57 Amendment of the following clause:

57a. In section 417 of the Commonwealth Act there were inserted after subsection (6) the following subsection:

(6A) Nothing in paragraph (1) (a) or subsection (8) applies to any corporation authorized by any Act or any law of the State to act as liquidator or, as the case may be, official liquidator of a company.
