An Act to amend the Crimes (Confiscation of Profits) Act, 1986.

[Assented to 21 April 1988]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Crimes (Confiscation of Profits) Act Amendment Act, 1988*.

(2) The *Crimes (Confiscation of Profits) Act, 1986*, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

Insertion of new s. 3a

2. The following section is inserted after section 3 of the principal Act:

Sentencing court not to have regard to forfeiture of property

3a. A court, in determining sentence for a prescribed offence, must not have regard to the question of whether or not the offender's property is, or could be, the subject of an application for forfeiture under this Act.
