An Act to amend the Constitution Act 1934.

[Assented to 2 November 1995]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Constitution (Salary of the Governor and Electoral Redistribution) Amendment Act 1995.
 - (2) The Constitution Act 1934 is referred to in this Act as "the principal Act".

Amendment of s. 73—Salary of the Governor

- 2. Section 73 of the principal Act is amended—
- (a) by striking out from subsection (1) "The salary" and substituting "Subject to subsection (1a), the salary";
- (b) by inserting after subsection (1) the following subsections:
 - (1a) After the commencement of the Constitution (Salary of the Governor and Electoral Redistribution) Amendment Act 1995 subsection (1) will continue to apply in relation to Her Excellency Dame Roma Mitchell but will not apply in relation to any subsequent Governor.
 - (1b) The commencing salary payable to a person who holds the office of Governor after Her Excellency Dame Roma Mitchell will be the same as the final salary paid to his or her predecessor in office and will be increased during the period of his or her term of office at the same time and by the same proportion as the salary of a puisne judge of the Supreme Court is increased during that period.

Amendment of s. 77—Basis of redistribution

3. Section 77 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from the definition of "the relevant date" in subsection (2) "two" and substituting "six".

Variation of s. 78—The Commission

- 4. Section 78 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after subsection (6) the following subsection:
 - (7) The members of the Commission (other than the Chairman) are entitled to remuneration determined by the Remuneration Tribunal.
