An Act to amend the Constitution of South Australia in such manner as to provide for a quinquennial Parliament, and for purposes incidental thereto.

(Reserved, October 12th, 1933. Royal Assent Proclaimed, February 28th, 1934.

E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as the "Constitution (Quinquennial Short title. Parliament) Act, 1933".
- 2. This Act is incorporated with The Constitution Act and all Incorporation, Acts amending that Act or incorporated therewith, and all the said 2 of 1855-6. Acts and this Act shall be read as one Act.
- 3. The following section is hereby enacted and inserted in The Enactment of new Constitution Act after section 3 thereof:

3A. Notwithstanding section 3 of this Act the House Duration of House of Assembly in existence at the time of the commencement of the Constitution (Quinquennial Parliament) Act, 1933, shall continue until the twenty-eighth day of February, nineteen hundred and thirty-eight, subject nevertheless to be sooner prorogued or dissolved by the Governor.
