An Act to amend the Coober Pedy (Local Government Extension) Act, 1981.

[Assented to 19 March 1987]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Coober Pedy (Local Government Extension) Act Amendment Act, 1987".

(2) The Coober Pedy (Local Government Extension) Act, 1981, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

Repeal of s. 5 and substitution of new section.

2. Section 5 of the principal Act is repealed and the following section is substituted:

Service of members of the Committee of the Association.

5. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Local Government Act, 1934, a person who, since the commencement of this Act, has served for a period of at least 12 months—

(a) as a member of the Committee of Management of the Association;

or

(b) as a member of the Committee of Management of the Association and then as a member of the council,

is eligible to be a candidate for election to the office of māyor of the council.
