*An Act to repeal An Act, No. 9 of 1852, intituled "An Act to regulate the Salaries of certain Clerks and subordinate Officers of the Crown in South Australia, and to establish rules for a progressive increase of the same for length of service."*

[Assented to, 24th December, 1858.]

**W**HEREAS an Act was passed, No. 9 of one thousand eight hundred and fifty-two, to regulate the salaries of certain clerks and subordinate officers of the Crown in South Australia and to establish rules for a progressive increase of the same for length of service—and it is expedient to repeal the same—Be it therefore Enacted by the Governor-in-Chief of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said Province, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. The said Act, No. 9 of one thousand eight hundred and fifty-two, is hereby repealed.
