## No. 1343.

An Act to amend the Dentists Act Further Amendment Act, 1917.

[Assented to, November 27th, 1918.]

**B**E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as the "Dentists Act Further Amendment Act, 1918." Short titles.

(2) The Dentists Acts, 1902 to 1917, and this Act may be cited together as the "Dentists Acts, 1902 to 1918."

(3) The Dentists Act Further Amendment Act, 1917, is herein-after referred to as "the principal Act." No. 1302 of 1917.

2. Section 11 of the principal Act is amended by inserting therein after paragraph v. of the said section the following paragraph:— Amendment of section 11 of principal Act—

*va.* Notwithstanding anything contained in paragraph v. of this section, if such person has on the first day of December, nineteen hundred and eighteen, or at any time within three months before such date, been on service outside Australia in any such force as mentioned in section 6 of this Act, such person may present himself for examination within one year from a date to be notified in that behalf by the Governor in the *Government Gazette*. Should he fail to pass such examination, he may again present himself for examination within

one year and a half from such notified date. Should he fail to pass such second examination, he may again present himself for examination within two years from such notified date. Should he fail to pass such third examination, he shall not be entitled to be registered under section 5 of this Act.
