An Act to amend the Dentists Act, 1931-1960.

[Assented to 17th November, 1966.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Dentists Act Amendment Act, 1966".

(2) The Dentists Act, 1931-1960, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Dentists Act, 1931-1966".

(3) The Dentists Act, 1931-1960, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

**Amendment of principal Act, s. 40 (1)—
Prohibition of practising dentistry without registration or licence.**

3. Subsection (1) of section 40 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after paragraph (c) thereof the following word and paragraph:—

; or

(d) he practises dentistry on school children under the immediate supervision of a registered dentist and—

(i) having undergone a course of training of not less than two years approved by the Minister and passed such examinations as the Minister specifies, is practising in the course of employment by the Crown;

or

- (ii) having completed one year of such course of training and passed such examinations as the Minister specifies, is practising in his course of training and pursuant to an agreement with the Minister.

4. Section 48 of the principal Act is amended by inserting at the end of paragraph (b) thereof the passage "or by a person practising dentistry on school children as mentioned in paragraph (d) of subsection (1) of section 40 of this Act".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 48—
Duties of dentists in relation to unregistered persons.

5. The principal Act is amended by striking out each passage therein representing an amount of money in terms of the currency provided for by the *Coinage Act* 1909-1947 of the Commonwealth and inserting in lieu thereof in each case a passage representing the equivalent amount of money in terms of the currency provided for by the *Currency Act* 1965 of the Commonwealth calculated on the basis of the equivalents specified in subsection (4) of section 8 of that Act.

General amendment of principal Act relating to decimal currency.
