An Act to further extend the Time for making certain Assessments required by the District Councils Act, 1914.

[Assented to, November 15th, 1917.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. This Act may be cited as the "District Councils Assessments Act, 1917." Short title.
2. The District Councils Assessment Validation Act, 1916, is hereby repealed. Repeal of Act No. 1258 of 1916.
3. Notwithstanding anything contained in any Act, section 159 of the District Councils Act, 1914, shall be read and construed to provide, and to have always provided, that the first new assessment thereby required to be made by every District Council, after the passing of the District Councils Act, 1914, may be made at any time before the expiration of the period of seven years next after such passing. First new assessment under District Councils Act, 1914, may be made at any time before 26th November, 1921.
