An Act to amend the Dairy Cattle Improvement Act, 1921-1960.

[Assented to 28th November, 1968.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Dairy Cattle Improvement Act Amendment Act, 1968".

(2) The Dairy Cattle Improvement Act, 1921-1960, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Dairy Cattle Improvement Act, 1921-1968".

(3) The Dairy Cattle Improvement Act, 1921-1960, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 6—
Every bull over six months old to be licensed.

2. Section 6 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (2) and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection :—

(2) If after the thirty-first day of July in any year any bull over the age of six months on the first day of that month is unlicensed, the owner of that bull shall be guilty of an offence against this Act and, on conviction, shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding forty dollars.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 10—
Duration and effect of licence.

3. Subsection (1) of section 10 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word "Every" being the first word of that subsection and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "Subject to subsection (2) of this section, every".

4. Section 13 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (2) the passage "twenty pounds" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "forty dollars".
- Amendment of principal Act, s. 13—
Power to require name and address and production of licence.
5. Section 14 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the passage "ten pounds" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "twenty dollars".
- Amendment of principal Act, s. 14—
Obstruction of officers.
6. Section 16 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (2) the passage "ten pounds" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "twenty dollars".
- Amendment of principal Act, s. 16—
Regulations.
7. The First Schedule to the principal Act is repealed and the following schedule is enacted and inserted in lieu thereof:—
- Repeal of First Schedule and substitution of new Schedule.

THE FIRST SCHEDULE.

Fees payable for Licences and Duplicate Licences.

For a licence for any bull over the age of six months on the first day of July in any year	\$2
For a duplicate licence	10c
