### No. 29 of 1959

An Act to amend the Dog Fence Act, 1946-1953.

[Assented to 3rd December, 1959.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Dog Fence Act Amendment Act, 1959". Short titles.

(2) The Dog Fence Act, 1946-1953, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Dog Fence Act, 1946-1959".

(3) The Dog Fence Act, 1946-1953, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. Section 22 of the principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection (the preceding portion of the section being read as subsection (1) thereof) :— Amendment of principal Act, s. 22—

(2) An owner of any part of the dog fence, who fails to comply with any of the provisions of subsection (1) of this section shall, in addition to any liability that may

be incurred under subsection (2) of section 23 of this Act, be guilty of an offence and liable to a penalty of not less than fifty pounds and not more than one hundred pounds.
