An Act to amend the Dried Fruits Act, 1934-1938.

[Assented to 20th November, 1941.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Dried Fruits Act Amendment Act, 1941". Short titles.

(2) The Dried Fruits Act, 1934-1938, and this Act may be cited together as the "Dried Fruits Act, 1934-1941".

(3) The Dried Fruits Act, 1934-1938, is hereinafter called "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. The following section is enacted and inserted in the principal Act after section 17 :— Enactment of s. 17a of principal Act.

17a. (1) The members of the board shall be entitled to be paid out of the revenue of the board such fees and allowances as are prescribed by regulation. Remuneration of board.

(2) All fees and travelling allowances paid to members of the board before the enactment of this section shall be deemed to have been paid in accordance with law.
