An Act to amend the Dairy Industry Act, 1923-1957.

[Assented to 27th November, 1958.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Dairy Industry Act Amendment Act, 1958".
- (2) The Dairy Industry Act, 1928-1957, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Dairy Industry Act, 1928-1958".
- (3) The Dairy Industry Act, 1928-1957, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Enactment of s. 22a of the principal Act—

3. The following section is enacted and inserted in the principal Act after section 22 thereof—

Colourable imitations of milk.

- 22a. (1) A person shall not manufacture or sell any liquid being a colourable imitation of milk and containing substances not derived from the lacteal secretion of the cow.
- (2) In a prosecution for an offence against this section it shall not be necessary for the prosecution to prove any

intention to deceive or other form of guilty knowledge and where the offence charged is a sale it shall be no defence that the defendant informed the purchaser of the true nature of the substance.
