An Act to amend "An Act to provide for the Election of Members to serve in the Parliament of South Australia."

[Assented to, December 11, 1856.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend an Act, No. 10 of 1855-6, "To provide for the Election of Members to serve in the Parliament of South Australia," in manner following—Be it therefore Enacted, by the Governor-in-Chief of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of the same, as follows:

1. In the event of two or more candidates to represent any electoral district being of the same name, the voting-paper, by the said Act directed to be given, shall contain the description of each such candidate, in addition to his Christian and surname.
