An Act to amend the Evidence Act, 1929.

[*Assented to, August 31st, 1933.*]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Evidence Act Amendment Act, 1933". Short titles.

(2) The Evidence Act, 1929 (which is hereinafter referred to as the "principal Act"), and this Act may be cited together as the "Evidence Acts, 1929 and 1933". No. 1907 of 1929;

2. Subsection (1) of section 21 of the principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the words "and shall only as regards the age or relationship of any child of the husband or wife be compellable". Amendment of principal Act, s. 21—Compellability of wife or husband as witness.
