No. 33 of 1958.**An Act to amend the Explosives Act, 1936.**

[Assented to 20th November, 1958.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Explosives Act Amendment Act, 1958".

(2) The Explosives Act, 1936, as amended by this Act may be cited as the "Explosives Act, 1936-1958".

(3) The Explosives Act, 1936, is hereinafter called "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of s. 42 of principal Act— Powers of Inspectors.

3. Section 42 of the principal Act is amended by adding at the end of paragraph (a) of subsection (1) the words "or any other place which it is necessary or convenient to enter, inspect or examine for the purpose of securing the due administration and enforcement of this Act".

Amendment of s. 52 of the principal Act— Regulations.

4. Section 52 of the principal Act is amended by inserting therein after paragraph XXIII the following paragraphs:—

XXIIIa. Regulating or restricting the mixing at any place of substances which, when mixed, form a product which can be used for blasting, and regulating or restricting the use of any such product for the purpose of blasting :

xxiii b. Prescribing any matters necessary or convenient to be prescribed for securing the due administration and enforcement of this Act.
