## An Act to amend the Encroachments Act, 1944.

[Assented to 4th December, 1969.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Encroachments Act Amendment Act, 1969".

(2) The Encroachments Act, 1944, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Encroachments Act, 1944-1969".

(3) The Encroachments Act, 1944, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Commencement.

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 2— Interpretation.

**3.** Section 2 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the definition of "subject land" the following definition :---

"the Land and Valuation Court" means the Land and Valuation Court constituted under the Supreme Court Act, 1935-1969. section is enacted and inserted in its place :---

3. The jurisdiction with which a court is invested under Jurisdiction. and pursuant to this Act (excepting section 11 of this Act) shall be exercised by the Land and Valuation Court.
