An Act to amend the Electricity Trust of South Australia Act, 1946.

[Assented to 2 May 1985]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Electricity Trust of South Australia Act Amendment Act, 1985".
- (2) The Electricity Trust of South Australia Act, 1946, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

Commencement.

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment of s. 43da— Clubs and refreshment rooms.

- 3. Section 43da of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by striking out subsection (3) and substituting the following subsection:
 - (3) The power to sell liquor conferred by this section shall not be exercised except in pursuance of a licence under the Liquor Licensing Act, 1985.;

and

- (b) by striking out the definition of "liquor" from subsection (7) and substituting the following definition:
 - "liquor" means liquor as defined in the Liquor Licensing Act, 1985.
