An Act to amend the Electrical Workers and Contractors Licensing Act, 1965-1966.

[Assented to 21st September, 1978]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Electrical Workers and Contractors Licensing Act Amendment Act, 1978".
- (2) The Electrical Workers and Contractors Licensing Act, 1965-1966, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Electrical Workers and Contractors Licensing Act, 1965-1978".

Amendment of principal Act, a. 2—
Interpretation.

2. Section 2 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the definition of "Minister".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 11— Establishment and constitution

- 3. Section 11 of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by inserting in subsection (3) after the word "Minister", where it occurs for the first time, the passage "of Mines and Energy";

and

- (b) by striking out subsection (4) and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection:—
 - (4) A member of the Committee shall be appointed for a term of five years.
