An Act to amend the Electrical Workers and Contractors Licensing Act, 1965-1966.

[Assented to 21st September, 1978]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Electrical Workers and Contractors Licensing Act Amendment Act, 1978".

(2) The Electrical Workers and Contractors Licensing Act, 1965-1966, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Electrical Workers and Contractors Licensing Act, 1965-1978".

2. Section 2 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the definition of "Minister".

3. Section 11 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by inserting in subsection (3) after the word "Minister", where it occurs for the first time, the passage "of Mines and Energy";

and

(b) by striking out subsection (4) and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection:—

(4) A member of the Committee shall be appointed for a term of five years.
