An Act to extend the operation of the Farmers Assistance Act, 1933-1936.

[Assented to 15th December, 1938.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Farmers Assistance (Extension) Act, 1938".

(2) The Farmers Assistance Act, 1933-1936, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Farmers Assistance Act, 1933-1938".

(3) The Farmers Assistance Act, 1933-1936, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of principal Act s. 12— Extension of tame for applications under Part III. 2. Section 12 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the passage "1937-1938, to which the Governor by proclamation directs that this Act shall apply" and by inserting in lieu thereof the passage "1939-1940".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 29— Extension of time for applications under Part IV. 3. Section 29 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word "thirty-eight" in the last line thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "forty".
