An Act to amend the Fisheries Act, 1917-1946.

[Assented to 15th November, 1956.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Fisheries Act Amendment Act, 1956". Short titles.

(2) The Fisheries Act, 1917-1946, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Fisheries Act, 1917-1956".

(3) The Fisheries Act, 1917-1946, is hereinafter called "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. The following section is enacted and inserted in the principal Act after section 7 thereof :— Enactment of s. 7a of principal Act—

7a. (1) The Minister shall have the following powers, namely :— Accommodation for fishing boats.

(a) to provide all or any of the following accommodation for fishing boats, namely, boat harbours, jetties, wharves, mooring places, slips and other like accommodation :

(b) to impose and recover charges for the use of any such accommodation, and in cases of hardship to compound or remit any such charges or part thereof :

(c) with the approval of the Governor to arrange with any other Minister or authority of the Crown for the construction of any such accommodation.

(2) The cost of providing any such accommodation shall be defrayed out of money voted by Parliament for the purpose.
