An Act to further amend the Food and Drugs Act, 1908,
and for other purposes.

[Assented to, December 16th, 1926.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia,
with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as
follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Food and Drugs Act Short titles.
Amendment Act, 1926."

(2) The Food and Drugs Acts, 1908 to 1924, and this Act may be
cited together as the "Food and Drugs Acts, 1908 to 1926."

2. This Act is incorporated with the other Acts mentioned in Incorporation.
section 1 of this Act and those Acts and this Act shall be read
as one Act.

3. Any foreshore, beach, seashore, jetty, pier, wharf, or breakwater Application of Food
and Drugs Acts
to foreshores and
jetties.
which abuts upon the boundary of the district of any local authority
shall for the purposes of the Food and Drugs Acts, 1908 to 1926,
be deemed, together with the approaches to such foreshore, beach,
seashore, jetty, pier, wharf, or breakwater, to be within such district.
