An Act to amend the Foot and Mouth Disease Eradication Fund Act, 1958.

[Assented to 22 September 1983]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Foot and Mouth Disease Eradication Fund Act Amendment Act, 1983".
- (2) The Foot and Mouth Disease Eradication Fund Act, 1958, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of s. 7—
Payments into fund.

.

2. Section 7 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from paragraph (b) the passage "or regulations made under this Act".

Amendment of s. 9—
Compensation.

- 3. Section 9 of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by striking out from paragraph (a) the passage "regulations made under the provisions of";

and

- (b) by striking out paragraph (b) and substituting the following paragraph:
 - (b) an animal that an inspector has certified as having died of foot and mouth disease.

Amendment of s. 13— Limits to compensation.

- 4. Section 13 of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by striking out from paragraph (a) the passage "sixty days" and substituting the passage "ninety days";

and

- (b) by striking out paragraph (b) and substituting the following paragraph:
 - (b) where—
 - (i) compensation would, but for this paragraph, be payable pursuant to this Act in respect of the

destruction or death of an animal or the destruction of property;

(ii) the owner of the animal or other property has failed to comply with this Act, the Stock Diseases Act, 1934, or any other law providing for the control or eradication of foot and mouth disease:

and

(iii) that failure has, in the opinion of the Minister, caused or contributed to the need to destroy the animal or other property or to the death of the animal,

the Minister may refuse payment of the whole or such part of the compensation that would otherwise be payable under this Act in respect of that animal or property as he determines.

5. Section 14 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the passage Amendment of s. 14— "or regulation made under this Act,".

6. Section 17 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the passage "or the regulations".

Amendment of s. 17-Summary
