An Act to amend the Fruit and Plant Protection Act, 1968.

[Assented to 28th October, 1976]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Fruit and Plant Protection Act Amendment Act, 1976". Short titles.

(2) The Fruit and Plant Protection Act, 1968, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Fruit and Plant Protection Act, 1968-1976".

2. Section 7 of the principal Act is amended—

- (a) by striking out the passage "The Governor may by proclamation" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "The Minister may, by notice published in the *Gazette*";
- (b) by striking out the word "proclamation" wherever it occurs in paragraphs (a), (b), (d), (e) and (f) of subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof, in each case, the word "notice";
- (c) by striking out from subsection (2) the word "proclamation" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "notice";

and

(d) by inserting after subsection (2) the following subsection:—

(3) The Minister may, by notice published in the *Gazette*, vary or revoke a notice under this section.

3. Section 9 of the principal Act is amended—

- (a) by striking out from subsection (1) the passage "The Governor may, by proclamation," and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "The Minister may, by notice published in the *Gazette*,";

(b) by striking out from subsection (1) the passage “the proclamation” and inserting in lieu thereof the passage “the notice”;

(c) by striking out from subsection (2) the word “proclamation” and inserting in lieu thereof the word “notice”;

and

(d) by inserting after subsection (2) the following subsection:—

(3) The Minister may, by notice published in the *Gazette*, vary or revoke a notice under this section.

4. Section 20 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after paragraph (g) the following paragraph:—

(ga) prescribing, and providing for the payment of, fees in respect of action taken by the Minister or an inspector under this Act;.
