An Act to further amend the Fire Brigades Act, 1913.

[Assented to, December 24th, 1924.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Fire Brigades Act Amendment Act, 1924." Short titles.

(2) The Fire Brigades Acts, 1913 and 1923, and this Act may be cited together as the "Fire Brigades Acts, 1913 to 1924."

(3) The Fire Brigades Act, 1913, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act" No. 1130 of 1913.

2. Subsection (1) of section 20 of the principal Act is amended by striking out all the words after "Board" in the first line, and inserting in lieu thereof the words "an annual fee of Two Hundred and Sixty Pounds." Amendment of principal Act, s. 20—
Chairman's fee.

3. Section 54 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out the words "three-ninths" in the fourth line thereof and by substituting therefor the words "two-ninths";

(b) by striking out the words "four-ninths" in the fifth line thereof and by substituting therefor the words "five-ninths"; and

(c) by striking out the words "four-ninths" occurring in the first and third lines of subsection (2) thereof and by substituting therefor in each case the words "five-ninths".
