An Act to further amend the Fire Brigades Act, 1913.

*[Assented to, November 6th, 1930.]*

**B**E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Fire Brigades Act Amendment Act, 1930". Short titles.

(2) The Fire Brigades Acts, 1913 to 1924, and this Act may be cited together as the "Fire Brigades Acts, 1913 to 1930".

(3) The Fire Brigades Act, 1913, is hereinafter referred to as No. 1130 of 1913. "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the other Acts mentioned in section 1 of this Act, and those Acts and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. (1) Section 54 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by adding at the end of subsection (1) thereof the following passage:—

" But if two-ninths of the said aggregate amount exceeds Ten Thousand Pounds, the amount to be paid as aforesaid by the Treasurer shall nevertheless be Ten Thousand Pounds, and the amount by which the said two-ninths exceeds Ten Thousand Pounds shall be

be contributed and paid (in addition to the other amounts mentioned in this subsection) to the Board in the following proportions :—

(i.) five-sevenths thereof by the insurance companies :

(ii.) two-sevenths thereof on behalf of the fire districts, and the municipalities and districts in which, or in parts of which, this Act applies” :

(b) by adding at the end of subsection (2) thereof the following passage :—

“ In this subsection the expression ‘ five-ninths ’ shall be deemed to include all amounts payable pursuant to subdivision II. and subdivision (i.) of subsection (1) hereof ” :

(c) by adding at the end of subsection (4) thereof the following passage :—

“ In this subsection the expression ‘ two-ninths ’ shall be deemed to include all amounts payable pursuant to subdivision III. and subdivision (ii.) of subsection (1) hereof ”.

(2) The amendments made by this section shall continue in force for a period of three years commencing from the first day of July, nineteen hundred and thirty, and no longer.
