An Act to amend the Fire Brigades Act, 1936-1958.

*[Assented to 30th August, 1973]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Fire Brigades Act Amend- Short titles.  
ment Act, 1973".
- (2) The Fire Brigades Act, 1936-1958, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Fire Brigades Act, 1936-1973".
- (3) The Fire Brigades Act, 1936-1958, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 68 of the principal Act is amended—

- (a) by striking out from paragraph (a) the passage "not less than two pounds nor more than ten pounds" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "not less than twenty dollars nor more than five hundred dollars";

and

Amendment of principal Act, s. 68—  
Tampering with fire alarms and giving false alarms.

(b) by striking out from paragraph (b) the passage “not less than ten pounds nor more than one hundred pounds” and inserting in lieu thereof the passage “not less than one hundred dollars nor more than one thousand dollars”.
