SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Fisheries (Contravention of Corresponding Laws) Amendment Act 2002.
 - (2) The Fisheries Act 1982 is referred to in this Act as "the principal Act".

Commencement

2. This Act will come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment of s. 44-Offences with respect to sale, purchase or possession of fish

- 3. Section 44 of the principal Act is amended—
- (a) by inserting in subsection (2)(a) "or a corresponding law" after "this Act";
- (b) by inserting in subsection (3)(a)(ii) "or a corresponding law" after "this Act";
- (c) by inserting in subsection (3)(b)(ii) "or a corresponding law" after "this Act";
- (d) by inserting after subsection (4) the following subsection:
 - (5) In this section—

"corresponding law" means a law of the Commonwealth or another State or a Territory of the Commonwealth that corresponds to this Act.
