An Act to further amend the Friendly Societies Act, 1919, and for other purposes.

[Assented to, December 7th, 1921.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Bell with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as the "Friendly Societies short titles. Act Amendment Act, 1921."
- (2) The Friendly Societies Act, 1919, and this Act may be cited together as the "Friendly Societies Acts, 1919 to 1921."
- (3) In this Act the Friendly Societies Act, 1919, is referred to as No. 1387 of 1919. "the principal Act."
- 2. (1) Section 7 of the principal Act is amended by inserting Amendment of after subdivision IV. of subsection (1) thereof the following sub- principal Act, s. 7 (1) division:—

v. for establishing and carrying on, under the management of a Friendly Society may pharmaceutical chemist registered under the Pharmacy shop. Act of 1891, the business of a pharmaceutical and dispensing chemist and druggist: Provided that, notwithstanding anything contained in the Taxation Act, 1915, the income derived from such business shall be liable to income tax.

(2) Subsection (1) of section 41 of the principal Act is amended by substituting for the passage "III. and IV." in the fifth line thereof the passage "III, IV., and V."
