An Act to amend the Gold Buyers Act, 1916-1935.

[Assented to 14th September, 1967]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Gold Buyers Act Amendment Act, 1967". Short titles.
- (2) The Gold Buyers Act, 1916-1935, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Gold Buyers Act, 1916-1967".
- (3) The Gold Buyers Act, 1916-1935, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.
3. Section 3 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the definition of "Chinese person" therein. Amendment of principal Act, s. 3—
Interpretation.
4. Section 15 of the principal Act is amended by striking out paragraph (a) thereof. Amendment of principal Act, s. 15—
Certain persons not to be licensed.
