An Act to amend the Governors' Pensions Act, 1976.

Reserved 18 June 1981
Royal Assent proclaimed 8 October 1981

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Governors' Pensions Act Amendment Act, 1981".
- (2) The Governors' Pensions Act, 1976, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".
- (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Governors' Pensions Act, 1976-1981".

Amendment of 8, 2— Interpretation.

- 2. Section 2 of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by striking out subparagraph (i) of paragraph (b) of the definition of "former Governor" and substituting the following subparagraph:
 - (i) after having served in that office-for a period (excluding periods of furlough) of not less than four years and six months;;

and

- (b) by inserting after the definition of "former Governor" the following definition:
 - "furlough", in relation to a Governor, means absence from office for recreational purposes for a continuous period of more than one month:

Reserved for the signification of Her Majesty the Queen's pleasure thereon.
