An Act to amend the Holidays Act, 1910.

[Assented to 30 March 1989]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Holidays Act Amendment Act, 1989.
- (2) The Holidays Act, 1910, is referred to in this Act as "the principal Act".

Public offices and banks to be closed on holidays

- 2. Section 6 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsections (2) and (3) and substituting the following subsections:
 - (2) Subsection (1) does not require the closure of a bank on a bank holiday if the opening of the bank on that day is authorized by a proclamation under subsection (3).
 - (3) The Governor may, by proclamation, authorize the opening of banks within a specified area on any bank holiday or holidays specified in the proclamation.
 - (4) The Governor may, by subsequent proclamation, vary or revoke a proclamation made under this section.
