No. 13 of 1943.**An Act to amend the Health Act, 1935-1941.**

[Assented to 9th December, 1943.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the " Health Act Amendment Act, 1943 ". Short titles.

(2) The Health Act, 1935-1941, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the " Health Act, 1935-1943 ".

(3) The Health Act, 1935-1941, is hereinafter referred to as " the principal Act ".

2. Section 83 of the principal Act is amended by inserting therein after paragraph (h) of subsection (1) thereof the following paragraphs :— Amendment of s. 83 of principal Act— Disposal of night soil.

(h1) carries or conveys any night soil through the streets except in a properly covered receptacle ;

(h2) suffers any night soil to be deposited on or to spill on to any street ;

3. Section 128 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by inserting after the word " tuberculosis " in the second line thereof the words " or any other form of tuberculosis " ; Amendment of s. 128 of principal Act— Notification of cases of tuberculosis.

(b) by inserting after the word " same " in the fourth line the passage " (together with particulars of the form of tuberculosis from which the person is suffering) ".
