An Act to amend the Health Act, 1935-1947.

[Assented to 2nd November, 1950.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Health Act Amendment Act, 1950".

(2) The Health Act, 1935-1947, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Health Act, 1935-1950".

(3) The Health Act, 1935-1947, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 101 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by inserting after the word "or" in the third line thereof the words "shall keep, or permit to be kept, or allow to be, in or about any slaughter-house".

(b) by adding at the end thereof the following subsection:—

(5) Any person who sells or offers for sale or has in his possession for sale any offal from any slaughter-house which is infected with any hydatid cyst shall be guilty of an offence against this Act and liable to a penalty not exceeding ten pounds: Provided that this subsection shall not apply to any such offal which has been thoroughly cleansed and boiled.
