No. 18 of 1957.**An Act to amend the Homes Act, 1941-1956.**

[Assented to 24th October, 1957.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Homes Act Amendment Act, 1957".

(2) The Homes Act, 1941-1956, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Homes Act, 1941-1957".

(3) The Homes Act, 1941-1956, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 7 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the words "one thousand seven hundred and fifty" in paragraph (a) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "two thousand two hundred and fifty".
