**An Act to amend the Health Act, 1935-1978.**

*[Assented to 17th April, 1980]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Health Act Amendment Act, 1980".
- (2) The Health Act, 1935-1978, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Health Act, 1935-1980".

Commencement.

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 87—  
Cesspools.

3. Section 87 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (1) the word "slaughterhouse,".

Repeal of s. 101 of principal Act.

4. Section 101 of the principal Act is repealed.

Repeal of ss. 103 to 109 of principal Act.

5. Sections 103, 104, 105, 106, 107, 108 and 109 of the principal Act are repealed.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 147—  
Regulations.

6. Section 147 of the principal Act is amended by striking out paragraphs (i), (j), (k), (l) and (m) of subsection (1).
