An Act to amend the Hospitals Act, 1934-1951.

[Assented to 30th October, 1952.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Hospitals Act Amendment Act, 1952".

(2) The Hospitals Act, 1934-1951, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Hospitals Act, 1934-1952".

(3) The Hospitals Act, 1934-1951, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Interpretation.

2. Section 49 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out paragraph (c) of the definition of "Government hospital" therein;

(b) by striking out the word "assurance" in the fourth to last line thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "insurance".
