An Act to amend the Holidays Act Amendment Act, 1958.

[Assented to 26th November, 1959.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Holidays Act Amendment Act, 1959".
- (2) The Holidays Act Amendment Act, 1958 (as amended by this Act) may be cited as the "Holidays Act Amendment Act, 1958-1959".
- (3) The Holidays Act, 1910-1947, as amended by the Holidays Act Amendment Act, 1958, and this Act may be cited as the "Holidays Act, 1910-1959".

Amendment of Holidays Act Amendment Act, 1958, s. 2.

2. Subsection (2) of section 2 of the Holidays Act Amendment Act, 1958, is amended by striking out the word "trading" therein and inserting in lieu thereof the word "savings".
