## No. 27 of 1958.

An Act to amend the Homes Act, 1941-1957.

[Assented to 6th November, 1958.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Homes Act Amendment Act, 1958".
- (2) The Homes Act, 1941-1957, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Homes Act, 1941-1958".
- (3) The Homes Act, 1941-1957, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 4—
Limit of guarantee.

2. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word "one-fifth" in the last line thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "one-quarter".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 7—Conditions of guarantee.

- 3. Section 7 of the principal Act is amended—
  - (a) by striking out paragraph (a) thereof;
  - (b) by inserting at the end thereof the following subsection (the preceding portion of the said section being read as subsection (1) thereof):—
    - (2) The Treasurer shall not execute a guarantee unless the loan, or the amount of purchase money exclusive of any sum paid as a deposit, accords with the following provisions:—

- I. If the amount of the loan or such purchasemoney does not exceed three thousand pounds, the said amount shall not exceed ninety-five per centum of the value of the dwellinghouse:
- II. If the amount of the loan or such purchasemoney exceeds three thousand pounds, the said amount shall not exceed eighty-five per centum of the value of the dwellinghouse:
- III. The amount of the loan or such purchase money shall not in any case exceed three thousand five hundred pounds.
