An Act to amend the Harbors Act, 1936-1966.

[Assented to 9th November, 1967]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Harbors Act Amendment Act, 1967".
- (2) The Harbors Act, 1936-1966, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Harbors Act, 1936-1967".
- (3) The Harbors Act, 1936-1966, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 78—
Power to authorize erection of wharves, etc.

- 3. Section 78 of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by striking out the words "the foreshore at any place within the State" therein and inserting in lieu thereof the words "any place within the limits of the jurisdiction of the Minister";
 - (b) by striking out the words "upon the foreshore and the land overflowed by the waters of the sea" therein and inserting in lieu thereof the words "in any portion of any such place";

and

- (c) by inserting at the end thereof the following subsection (the preceding portion of the section as amended by paragraphs (a) and (b) of this section being designated as subsection (1) thereof):-
 - (2) Every licence granted pursuant to this section as amended and in force immediately prior to the commencement of the Harbors Act Amendment Act, 1967, to an owner or occupier of any land fronting and immediately adjoining any portion of the River Murray shall be and be deemed to be and at all times to have been valid and effectual for all purposes.
- 4. Section 144 of the principal Act is amended by striking Amendment of principal Act, therefrom paragraphs (49) to (52) inclusive. out therefrom paragraphs (49) to (52) inclusive.

Regulations.

5. Section 168 of the principal Act is repealed.

Repeal of s. 168 of principal Act— Unlicensed person acting as ships' surveyor.
